- 1. Jesus: *MUST SING* Kind, compassionate, and humble servant who embodies love, yet unwavering in truth (John 14:6).
- 2. **Pilate**: *MUST SING* Authoritative Roman leader with the power of life and death, firm and pragmatic (Matthew 27:2).

Supporting and Interviewee Descriptions

- 1. Waffle House Waitress: Cheerful and welcoming, adding humor and lightheartedness.
- 2. Jairus' Daughter: Innocent and young, miraculously restored to life (Mark 5:37-47).
- Mother of Jairus' Daughter: Overwhelmed with awe and gratitude for Jesus' power (Mark 5:37-47).
- 4. **Barabbas**: A notorious criminal freed in place of Jesus, symbolizing the crowd's misguided choice (Matthew 27:16).
- Prisoner 1 (Repentant): MUST SING Reflective and remorseful, open to Jesus' promise of redemption (Luke 23:39-43).
- 6. **Prisoner 2 (Impenitent)**: *MUST SING* Hardened and skeptical, grappling with disbelief and the possibility of mercy (Luke 23:39-43).
